WE ARE PLEASED TO CONFIRM THAT AS PER CURRENT GOVERNMENT TIMETABLE WE WILL RE-OPEN ON MONDAY 17th MAY at 11AM.

Membership

The committee agreed that in light of the repeated lockdowns, we will offer everyone a year's free membership of the Club

What this means is that we will extend everyone's renewal date by 1 year from your existing expiry date.

- If you wish to take advantage of this offer and pay by standing order, you will need to amend it to miss your next payment and resume a year later.
- If you do not pay by standing order, then just wait for a reminder from us which will be based on the updated renewal date.
- If you do not wish to take advantage (and the club will be grateful for any members who do this), then pay as normal at your existing renewal date.

For those members that are not up to date with their fees, we will send out reminders on your new expiry date. For those very few members who would have expired more than 12 months ago (during first lockdown), we will send out reminders in the next few days as your free year will have been used.

Please note that any renewals we have had during lockdown would have automatically picked up your actual renewal date, not from the date you paid, even if that was later.

For example, if your renewal date was 1 Oct 2020 and you paid in March 2021, then your current expiry date will be 1 Oct 2021. Under the above proposal we will amend your renewal date to 1 Oct 2022. If you still pay on 1 Oct 2021, then your renewal date will not move again

NOTE THAT THIS ONLY APPLIES TO THE CLUB MEMBERSHIP. YOU MUST STILL MAINTAIN YOUR BRITISH LEGION MEMBERSHIP AND THEIR PAYMENT SCHEDULES

We have now received the new membership cards and they will be available to pick up when we re-open.

ANTICIPATED RULES FOR MAY

- Table Service
- You must wear a mask when moving around the club.
- Ensure you swipe your membership card when entering the club so we can meet track and trace rules (even if you are entering the club with another member).
- You are allowed to bring guests in after re-opening (as per club rules)
