On Sunday 1st Feb, we sadly have to put our prices up again.

Non-member prices will rise by approx. 21% but at the same time we will increase the Member discount to 20% which will result in member prices going up by between 7 and 9%. Please remember that half of that increase is due to government tax increases.

For example, A Pint of Carlsberg will go from £4.22 to £5.06 for non-member and from £3.80 to £4.05 for a member
